



Hello! I would like to bring to your attention an anti-crime program that our school district is using and is currently in use in many school districts throughout California. Specifically, the program is called “WeTiP” and this is a 24 hour a day hotline where students, staff, parents and community members may call to report a crime. This program stresses anonymity to ensure anyone who calls does not have to worry about being a “snitch”, fear retaliation, etc. The number is 1-800-78-CRIME and the website URL is

www.wetip.com. Rewards up to \$1,000 are offered for information that is helpful in the arrest and conviction of the responsible person(s). Examples of crimes this hotline has been used for in the past include vandalism, gang violence, graffiti, hate crimes, weapons on campus, etc.
