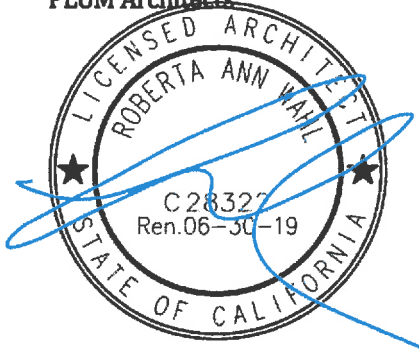

Item No. 1: Specification Section 01 11 00 (1.03) (A.): Add paragraph 3. to read as follows:

3. Remove, repair, clean-up and dispose of exterior redwood trim coated with lead-based paint (LBP) to the extent necessary to support removal of wood inserts where existing wall mounted HVAC units were removed to support new window installation. For Bidding Purposes, the Contractor shall assume that approximately 20% of the window openings where the wood inserts are removed will require removal and repair work which impacts exterior redwood trim coated with LBP. Removal and / or repair work shall be conducted in accordance with Specification Section 02 83 00.
