The **Sigma Iota** Chapter of the **Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.** offers financial support to targeted African-American high school seniors who plan to continue their education at a four (4) year university or college. Since the inception of our organization Omega men have epitomized the meaning behind the phrase “academic excellence”.

- **\$1,500 Sigma Iota Funded Scholarship Awards** (multiple awards will be given).

Eligibility

- African-American graduating high school students (Class of 2022) who are enrolled in a four (4) year program at a university or college for the Fall 2022 and Winter 2023 semesters.
- Alameda or Contra Costa County Resident
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 Scale
- Active in Community Service Initiatives
- Meets the Criteria set forth by all four Cardinal Principles:
 - Manhood/Womanhood-Having a sense of responsibility and humane qualities.
 - Scholarship-Ability to show quality performance inside as well as outside the classroom.
 - Perseverance-The ability to start a task and finish it despite difficulties.
 - Uplift- The ability to elevate or raise those around you.

Instructions

1. All applications must be typed or completed in blue or black ink and submitted by **April 1, 2022**. Applications postmarked after April 1, 2022 will be disqualified.
2. Submit an official school acceptance letter from a university or college.

3. Submit **two** (2) written recommendations, preferably from a teacher, counselor, employer or community leader.
4. Submit Official High School Transcripts.
5. Submit a **500** word essay discussing the following topic:

What specific actions would you recommend to address the historical inequities in access to health care in the African American communities in general; and, specifically as it relates to the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on African Americans.

6. Participate in an interview with the Sigma Iota Scholarship Committee

Successful applicants will be notified by mail no later than June 1, 2022. Awards will be announced at the annual Sigma Iota Chapter scholarship banquet ceremony (date tbd) and the SF Bay Area Pan Hellenic Council Reception (date tbd).

Upon official confirmation of school enrollment and attendance for the Fall 2022 semester, recipients will receive payment of scholarship award.
