4. Provide a letter of recommendation from your Junior Achievement volunteer(s), teachers, employers and/or others.
5. Contact the schools of your choice and:
 - a. Verify that your application has been received and is complete. Update any information, such as address or telephone number, with changes.
6. Complete and submit the Free Application for Financial Student Aid (FAFSA). This is available on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
7. If you are selected as an awardee, please note you will be required to fulfil the following requirements:
 - a. Five hours of volunteer service to JA annually (in any region)
 - b. Attend an annual lunch in the summertime in Northern California
 - c. Join JA Northern California on social media
 - d. Write a prompt thank you letter
 - e. Maintain a 2.75 in college
 - f. Enroll in 12 credits per/semester (full time).
