To Whom It May Concern,

The National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Anne Loucks Chapter is offering a \$1,000.00 scholarship for qualified students.

The scholarship shall be awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, natural origin, or disability. Applicants shall not submit photographs of themselves. The deadline for submitting applications shall be April 15, 2022. Notifications of awards to applicants shall be postmarked by April 30, 2022, or earlier. The award will be made in the late spring. The award shall be made based on the applicant's service to the community. Work in the areas of historic preservation, history education, or patriotism shall be preferred by but not required.

A successful applicant must meet the following criteria (1) be a Contra Costa County resident (2) be an accepted and enrolled student in an accredited school; (3) have a grade- point average of 3.0 or above and submit an original transcript as proof of his or her grade- point average; (4) submit at least two letters of recommendations from the appropriate personnel at the school he or she is attending; (5) be an American citizen and submit proof of citizenship (photocopy of birth certificate or naturalization papers); (6) Provide evidence of any work he or she has done in community service. Work in the areas of historic preservation, history education or patriotism is preferred but not required; (7) provide verification of his or her community service; (8) submit a statement of approximately 500 words listing (a) how and why he or she has served the community and (b) his or her personal and education goals and (8) provide a self -addressed, stamped envelope with his or her application.
