STONEMAN MISSION STATEMENT

Our mission is to create an environment that engages students in academic work that results in a high level of achievement. We are confident that with our support and help, students can master challenging curricula, and we expect them to do so. We are prepared to work collaboratively with colleagues, students, parents and the community to achieve this shared educational purpose.

K-8 MANDATORY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY- BP 5132(b)

The governing Board believes that appropriate dress and grooming contributes to a productive learning environment. The Board recognizes that in order to promote student safety and discourage theft, peer rivalry and/or gang activity the Board may wish to establish a dress code requiring students to wear uniforms. Such a dress code shall be included as part of each school's safety plan.

The Board shall approve the plan upon determining that it is necessary to protect the health and safety of the school's students and maintain a positive school climate.

Uniforms are:

- White or Navy blue collared top (i.e. polo shirts) No T-shirts
- Navy blue bottoms (i.e. pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers). No jeans
- Sweaters should be solid navy blue or white.
- Shoes/foot coverings must be worn at all times, and must be safe and appropriate for the activities in which the student is engaged. (i.e. athletic shoes must be worn for PE) No slippers, No flip flops, No sandals

Each school may require more specific attire. If you have any questions, please contact the Stoneman office.

Satisfactory school progress is dependent upon regular school attendance.

An EXCUSED absence is:

- Illness or injury of the student, or serious illness which necessitates the absence of the student
- Medical or dental appointment; please bring note from doctor
- Attendance at the funeral of an immediate family member
- Appearance in court
- Observance of holiday or ceremony of his/her religion.

Clearing an absence:

- **Please all the Attendance Line available 24/7: (925) 473-2431** or email Christina Mota: cmota@pittsburg.k12.ca.us on the day of an absence to report the reason for the absence.
- **If the absence has not been previously cleared by phone or email, the student must have a written note signed by the parent.**

Appointments during the school day:

- Send a note to your child's teacher the day of the appointment, advising what time your student will be called for.
- Come into the office and sign your student out. The office staff will then call the classroom to ask for the student.
- Upon the student's return, the parent must come into the office and sign the student back into school.

Tardies:

- If a student arrives after 8:15 a.m., he/she will need to go to the office to get a tardy pass before going to class.

Drop Off and Pick Up

Stoneman is committed to student safety. In order to insure that all students are safe during drop off and pick up times, parents must adhere to the following guidelines:

Parents are to find a parking spot, or use the pickup/drop off loop. There is no parking allowed in the RED fire lane, or next to our coned off pickup/drop off loop.



All students must be dropped off/picked up in the coned area pictured above.



Students are NOT to be dropped off or picked up in the red fire lane.

We Love to celebrate student birthdays at Stoneman,

however;

only the following is acceptable:

- Donate a book to the Stoneman Library. We will inscribe the book with your student's name and birthdate, and it will be available for checkout in our library! Students' will also be given a birthday certificate.
- Birthday bags with classroom supplies such as pencils, erasers etc. (no toys/candy/etc.) for the students in your child's class.
- Prearrange with classroom teacher, a date to bring a healthy snack for the classroom. **Here is a list for appropriate healthy snacks:**
 - *Applesauce, Bagels, Bread Sticks, Cereal Bar, Chex Mix, Crackers, Fresh Fruit, Fruit Bowls, Goldfish, Granola Bars, Jerky, Muffins, Nutri Grain Bars, Popcorn (no butter), Pretzels(mini), Pudding snack pack, Rice cracker, Vegetables, Yogurt*
- **No Flowers, No Balloons, No Toys or Food (that is not on the healthy snack list).**

Parent/Visitor on School Campus

- Observe classroom or school activities without disrupting (Education Code 32210)
- Observe school rules and/ or district policies regarding access to school grounds
- Turn off cell phones (texting or talking on cell phones is not permitted in classrooms or hallways)
- Leave younger children at home

Parents/Guardians are encouraged to work cooperatively with the school staff in fostering positive behavior in students. By working together we hope to further develop characteristics such as:

- Respect for themselves and others
- Consideration for the rights of others
- Courteous behavior and language
- Obedience to rightful authority
- A desire to learn

We welcome parents/guardians to visit their child's classroom and be positive role models for our students. It is very important that we maintain a safe school environment for our students, staff and parents.

Parent/Guardian or visitors who do not conduct themselves in a civil manner will be escorted off campus with the possibility of further actions taken to secure the safety of our students.
