

Pittsburg Unified School District: COVID-19 Guidance January 11, 2022

<p>Positive Case of COVID-19</p> <p>Staff and Students: regardless of vaccination status</p>	<p>Stay home and isolate for at least 5 days. If do not have any symptoms and have a negative test (antigen test recommended) on Day 5 or later, may return. Day 6 would be earliest date to return. Onset of symptoms or positive test, whichever was first, is day 0.</p> <p>If unable to test, or test on day 5 is still positive, stay home until negative test or 10 days (return on day 11).</p> <p>If negative and still have fever, stay home until without fever for 24 hours</p>	<p>Antigen tests are available for all staff at the North Campus and Youth Development Center Locations.</p> <p>Home antigen tests are acceptable for staff and students, with attestation form and photo of negative test</p> <p>Employees: submit to HR (if not Predicine)</p> <p>Students: submit to school</p>
<p>Close Contact/Staff: Exposed to a Positive Case of COVID-19</p> <p>Staff: Boosted or Vaccinated and not yet eligible for Booster</p> <p>Staff: Vaccinated and Booster Eligible but have not yet received Booster</p> <p>Staff: Unvaccinated</p>	<p>If asymptomatic, do not have to quarantine. Test on Day 5. (Can be PCR or antigen)*</p> <p>If asymptomatic, do not have to quarantine, and must obtain a negative test within day 3-5 (Can be PCR or antigen)*</p> <p>Quarantine for at least 5 days from contact. Test on Day 5. (Can be PCR or antigen)* If asymptomatic and negative test, can return to work on Day 6. If unable to test, quarantine ends after Day 10.</p>	

	<p>*Persons previously infected with COVID-19 within the last 90 days should have an antigen test</p>	
<p>Close Contact/Student: Exposed to a Positive Case of COVID-19: CDPH has not made changes yet to quarantine for students</p> <p>Students: Vaccinated</p> <p>Students Exposed at School: Not fully Vaccinated, masks worn by both</p> <p>Students Exposed at School: Not fully vaccinated, one or the other masks not worn during exposure</p> <p>Students: Exposed at Home/Outside of School:</p> <p>Vaccinated</p>	<p>Does not need to stay home; monitor for symptoms, recommend testing on day 5 (Can be PCR or antigen)*</p> <p>Modified Quarantine, does not need to stay home, test 2 times over 10-day period (recommend test right away and again after day 5)</p> <p>Stay home and quarantine for at least 7 days, test on Day 5 or after (Can be PCR or antigen*); if negative can return on Day 8. Otherwise, return on Day 10 if no symptoms.</p> <p>If no symptoms, do not have to quarantine. Recommend Test on Day 5. (Can be PCR or antigen*)</p>	

<p>Unvaccinated</p>	<p>Stay home and quarantine for at least 7 days, test on Day 5 of exposure or after (Can be PCR or antigen*); if negative can return on Day 8. (If student is living with someone who is positive, then exposure starts the day after the positive person's 5-10 day period...5 days or after with a negative test or 10 days)</p>	
<p>Symptoms of COVID-19 without being a Close Contact: Staff and Students</p>	<p>Stay home and test (Can be PCR or antigen*) Can return to school/work if test is negative and no symptoms OR if the primary care doctor ruled out COVID-19. With no test, stay home for 10 days or 24 hours after fever.</p> <p>*Persons previously infected with COVID-19 within the last 90 days should have an antigen test</p>
