LCAP Priority Survey 2019-20



- A new LCAP Priority feedback survey was introduced in Late Fall 2019.
- As of 2/2/2020 1,625 parents, staff and/or community members have responded to the survey, as follows:
 - 991 Parents or Guardians
 - 54 Students (Scholars)
 - 430 Certificated Staff (PEA)
 - 148 Classified Staff (CSEA)
 - 25 Administrators
 - 26 Other PUSD Staff
 - 77 Community Members(note: counts reflect that some responders identified in more than one role)

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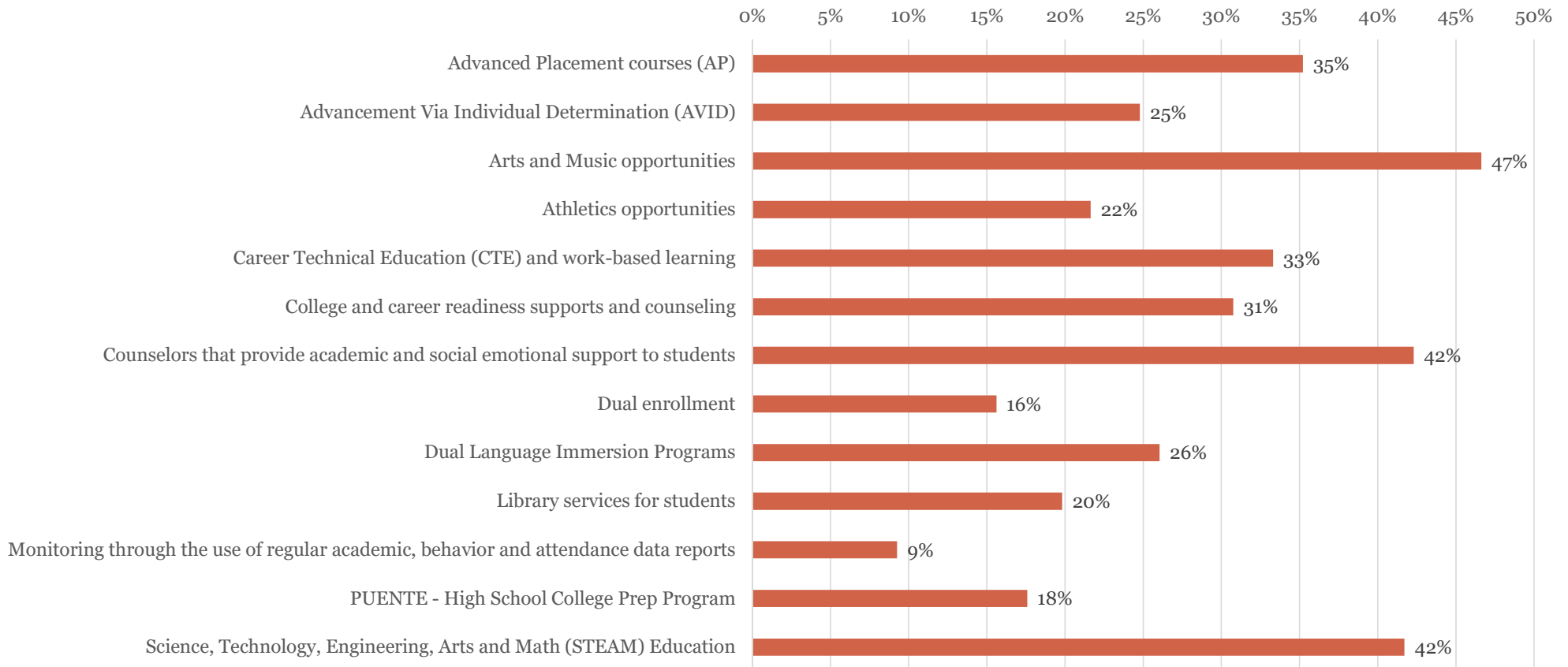

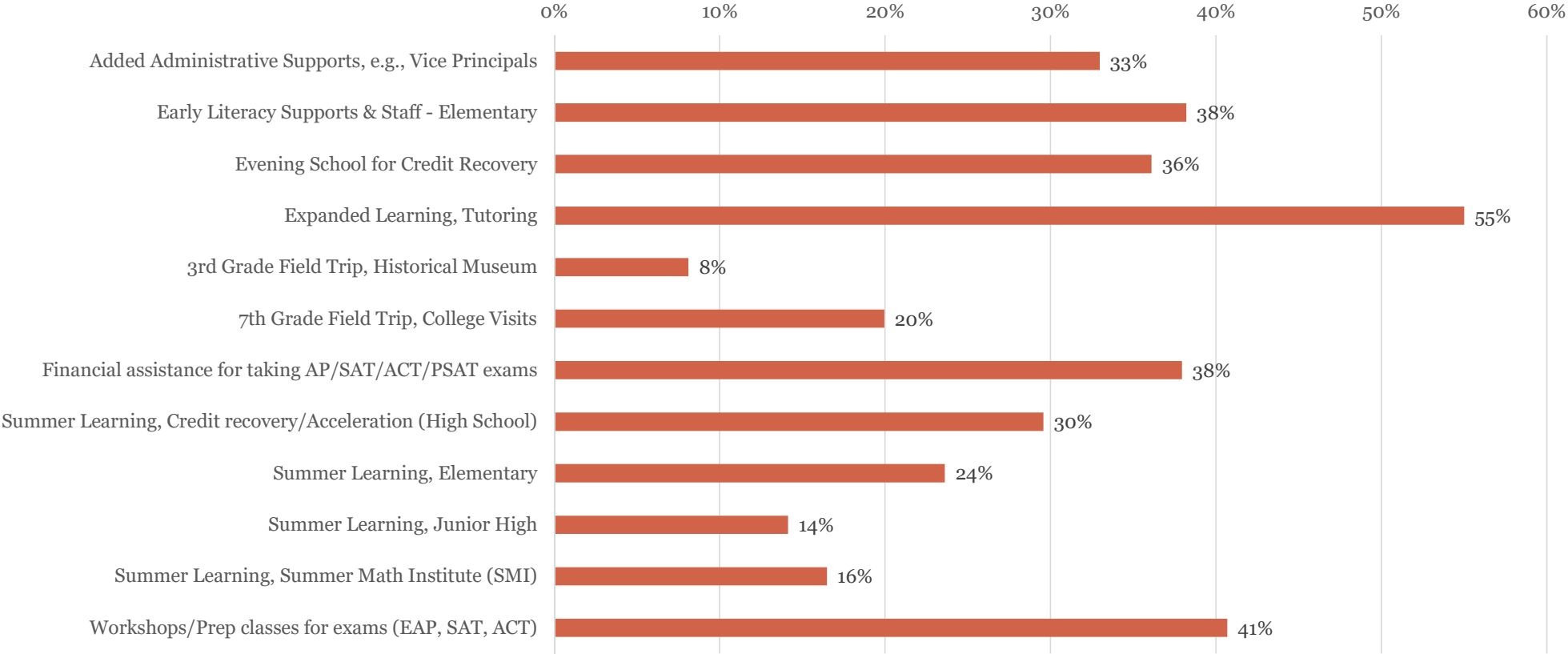

Of 1,625 Respondents, 1529 Rated in this Area, 96 Skipped

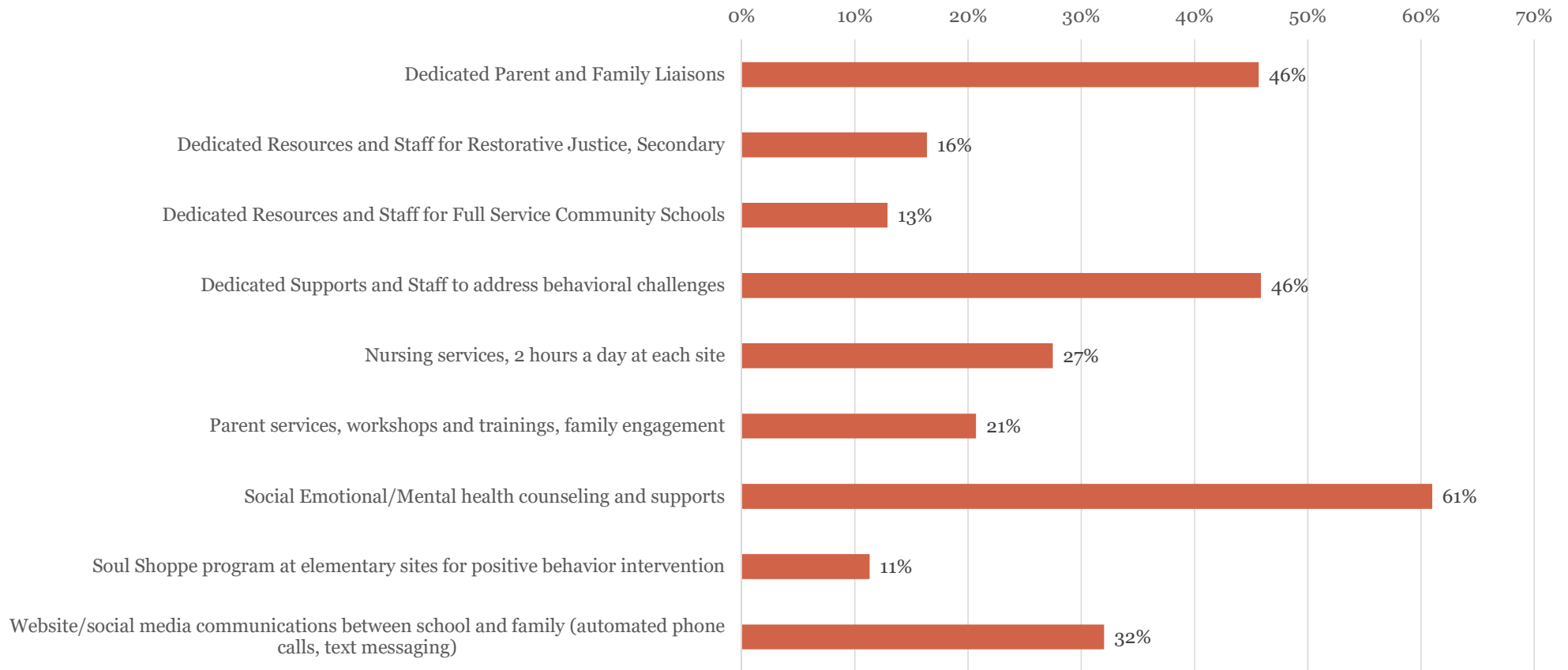


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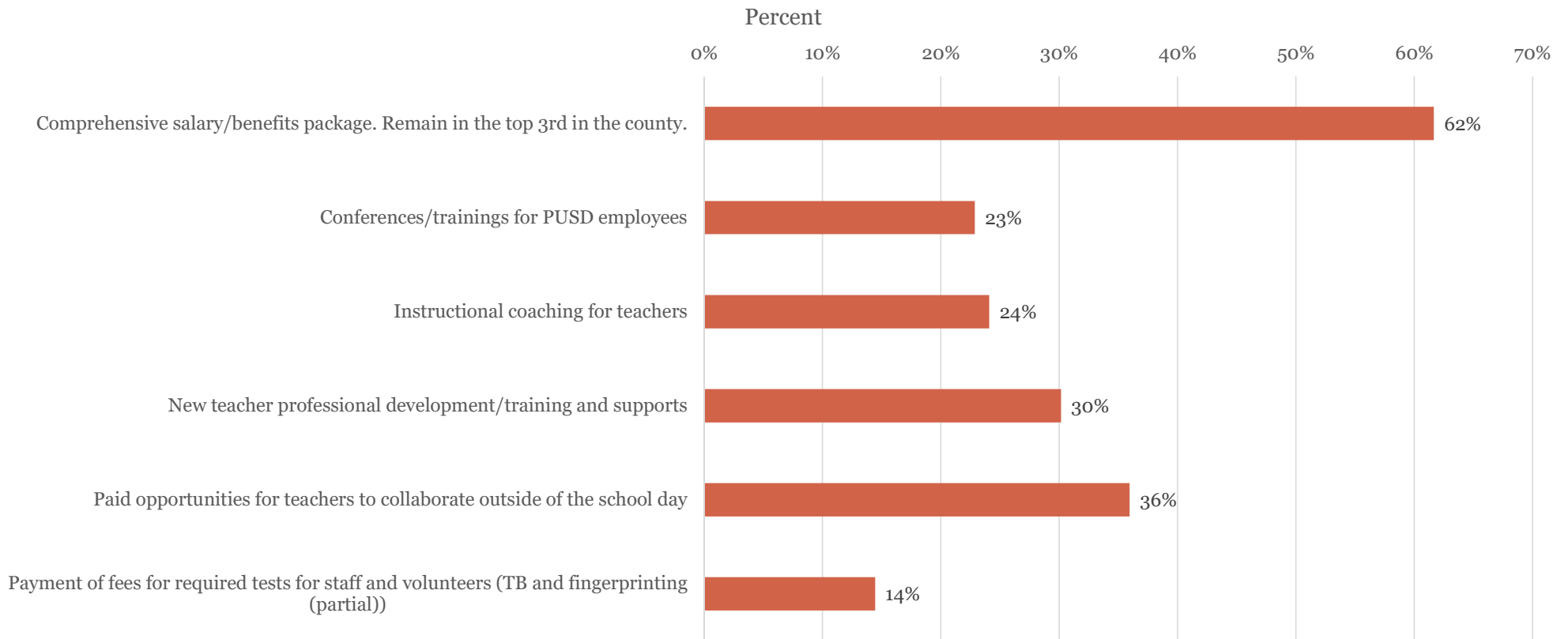

Of 1,625 Respondents, 1,522 Rated in this Area, 103 Skipped



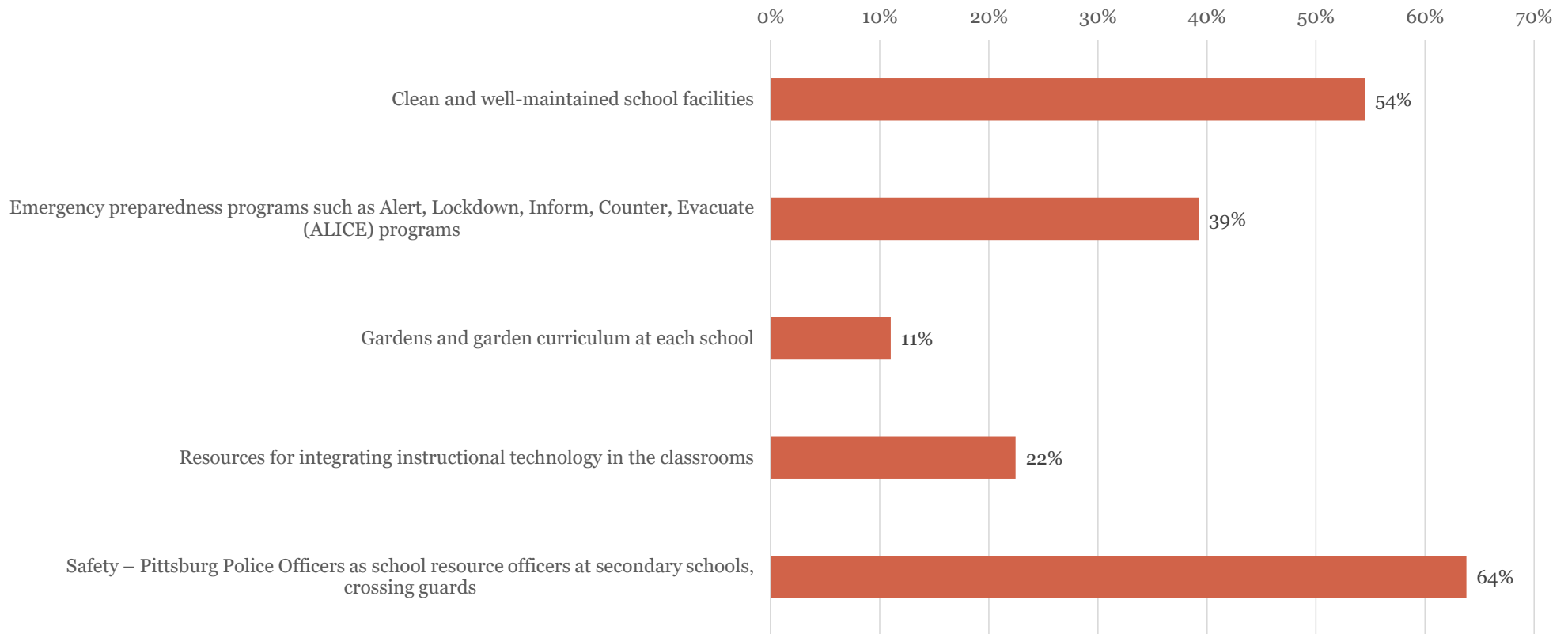

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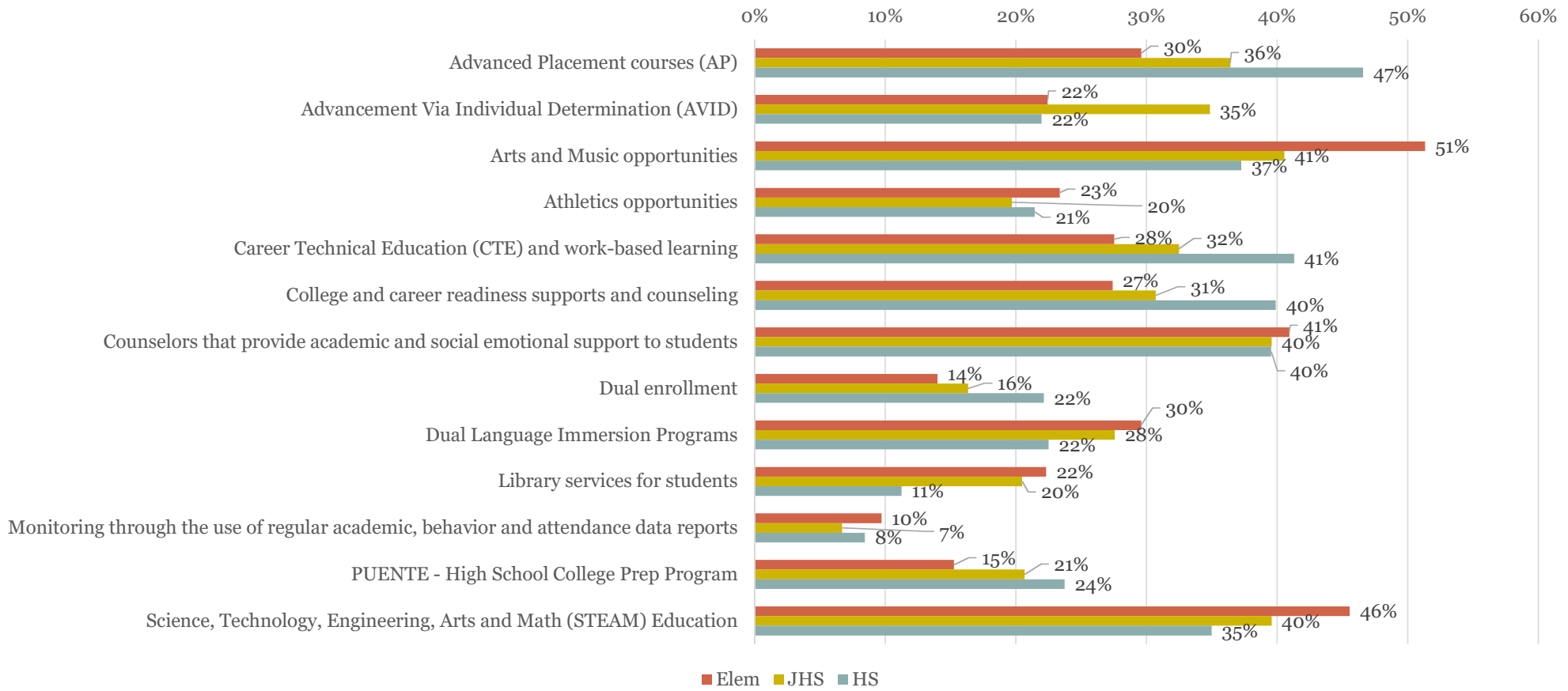

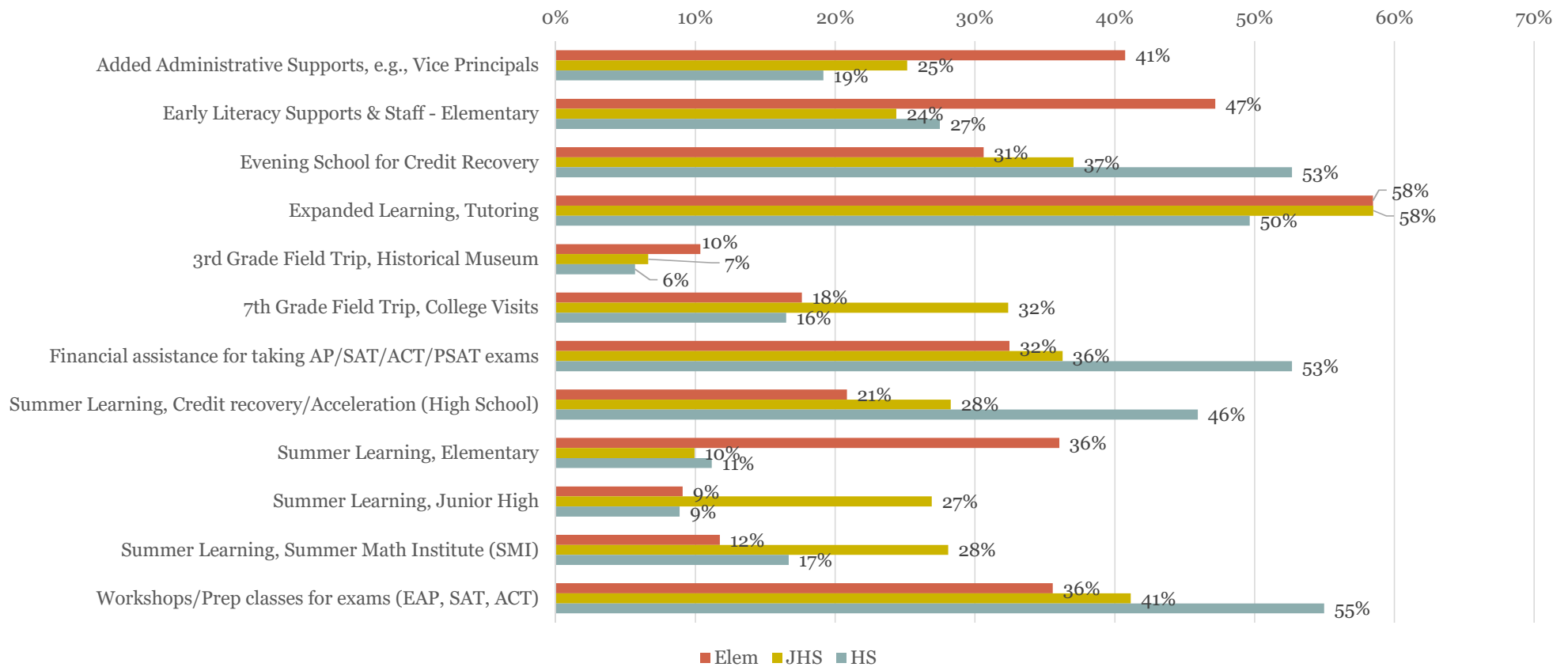


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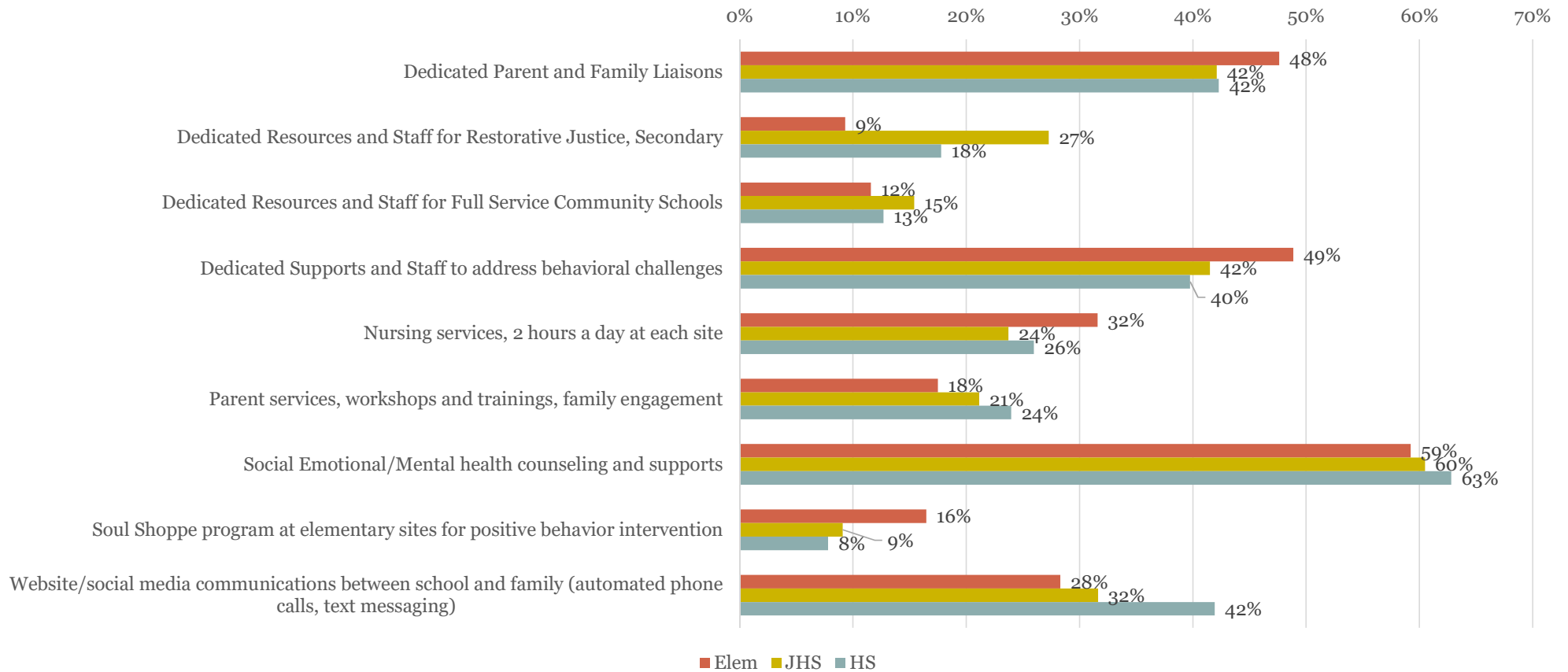

Respondents By Division, Elem: 869; JHS: 513; HS: 564



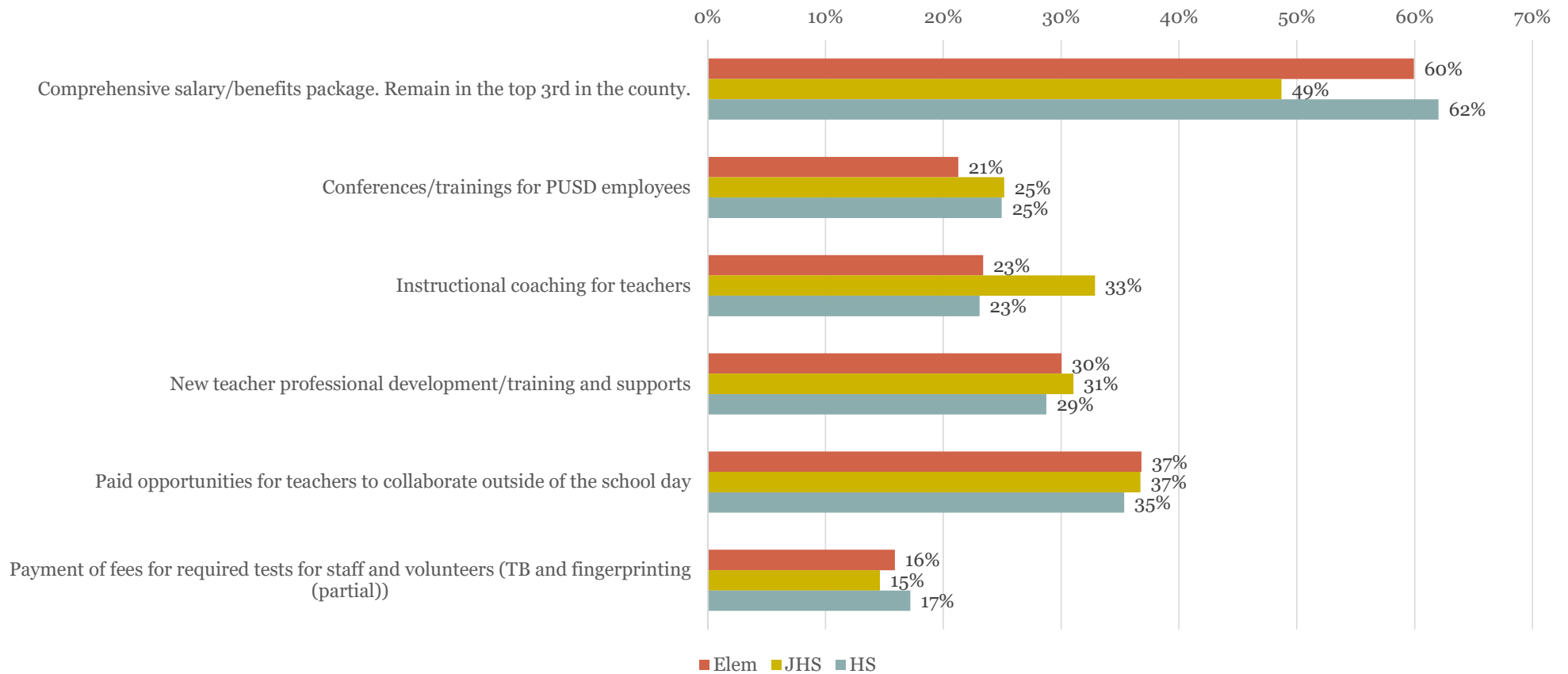

Respondents by Division, Elem: 880; JHS: 506; HS: 551



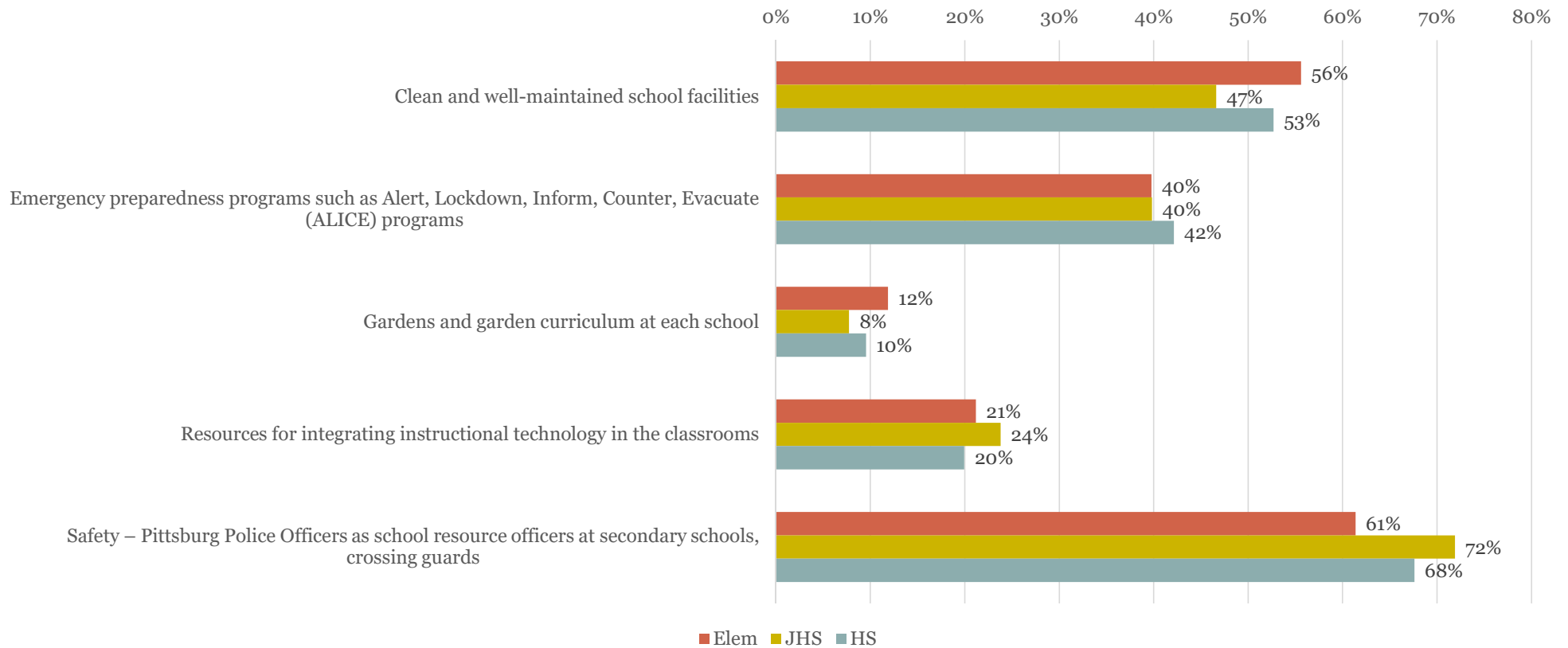

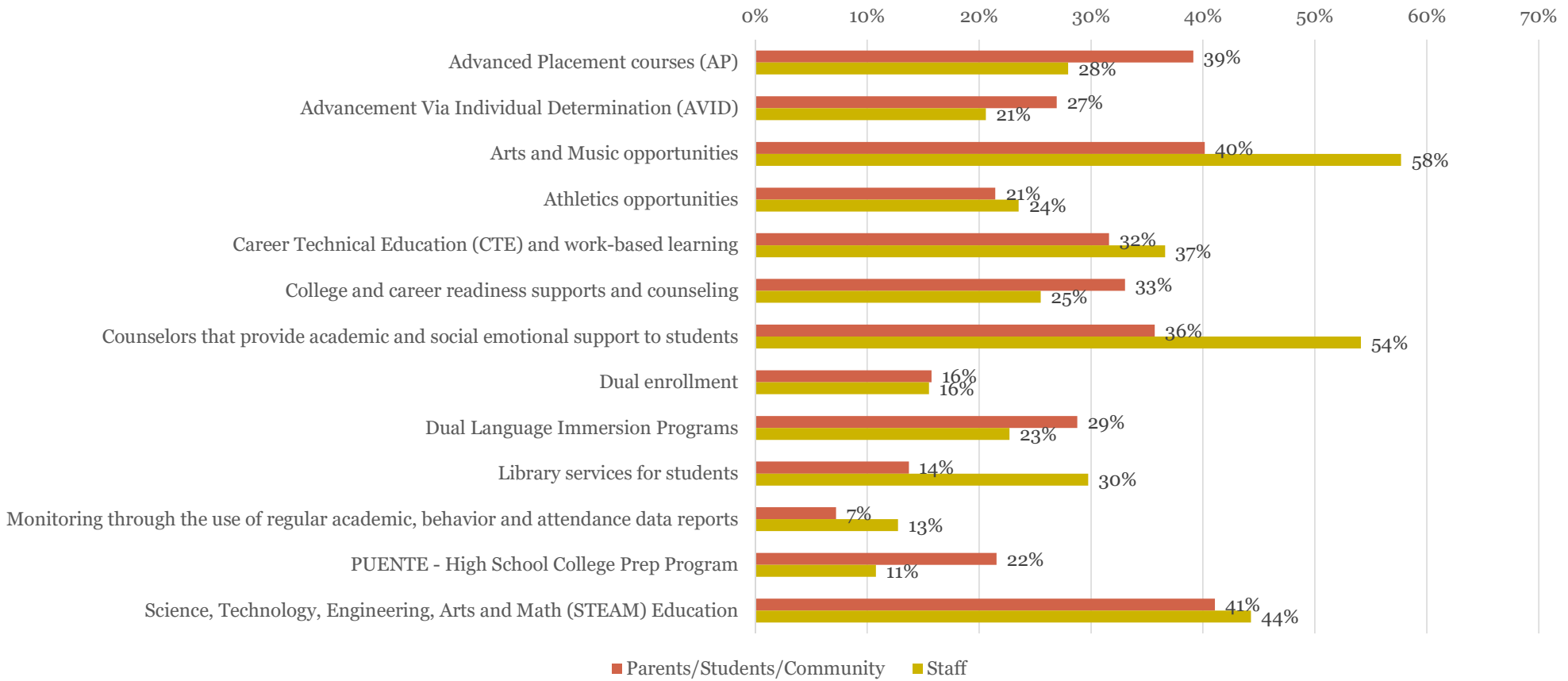

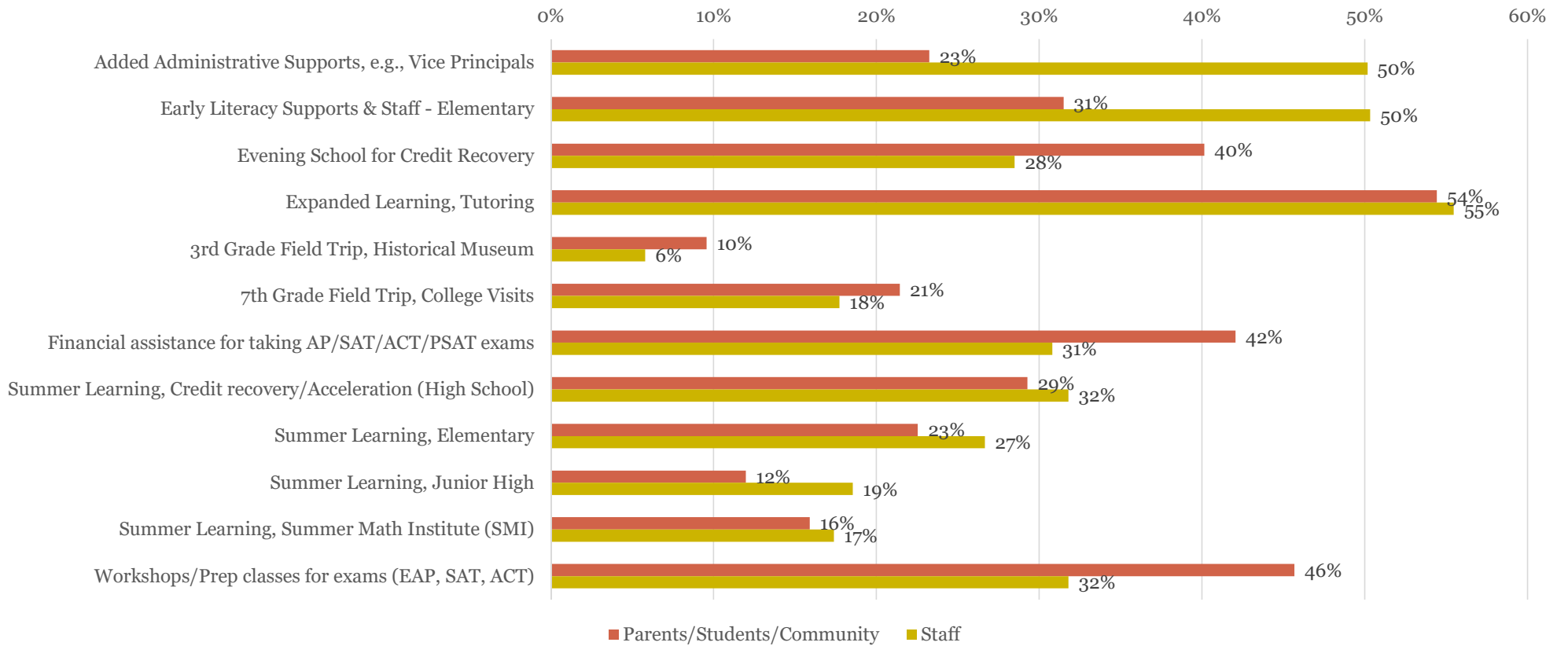

Respondents by Group, Parents/Students/Community: 984; Staff: 612



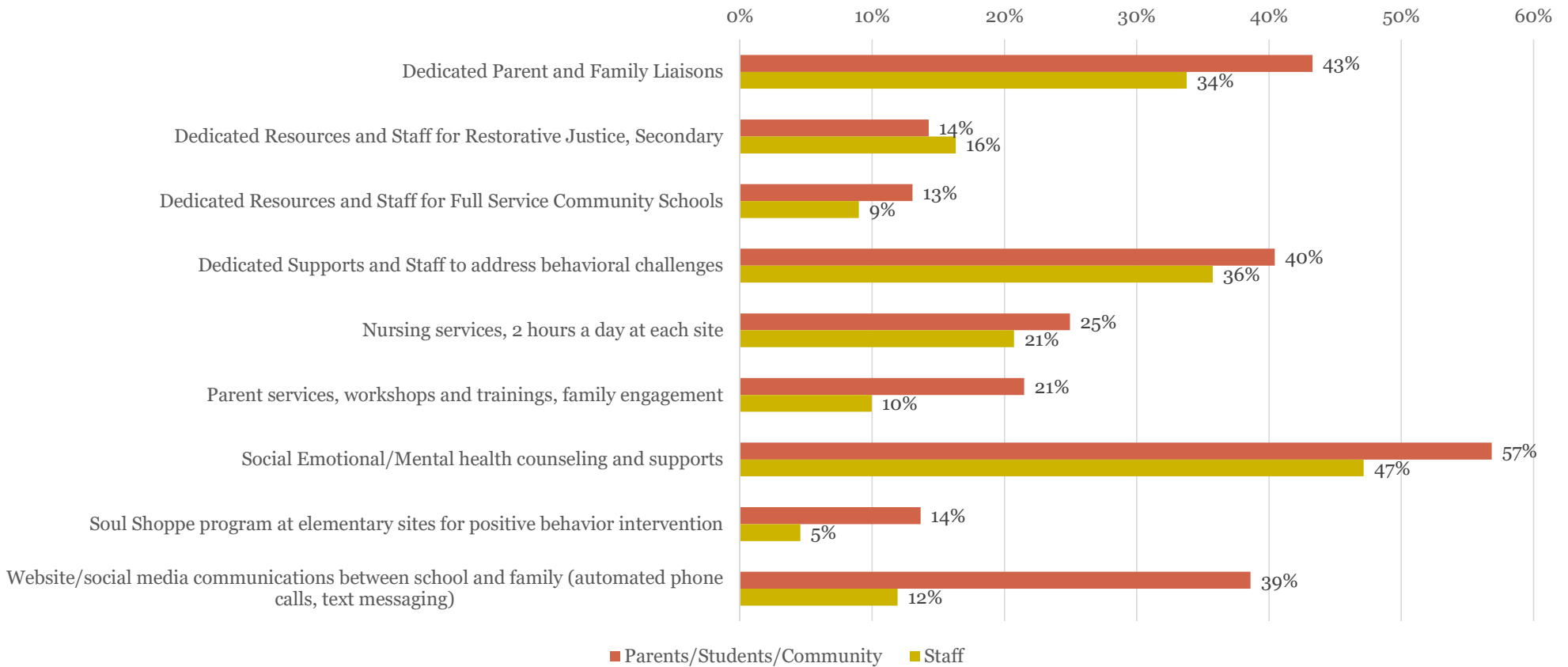

Respondents by Group, Parents/Students/Community: 994; Staff: 604



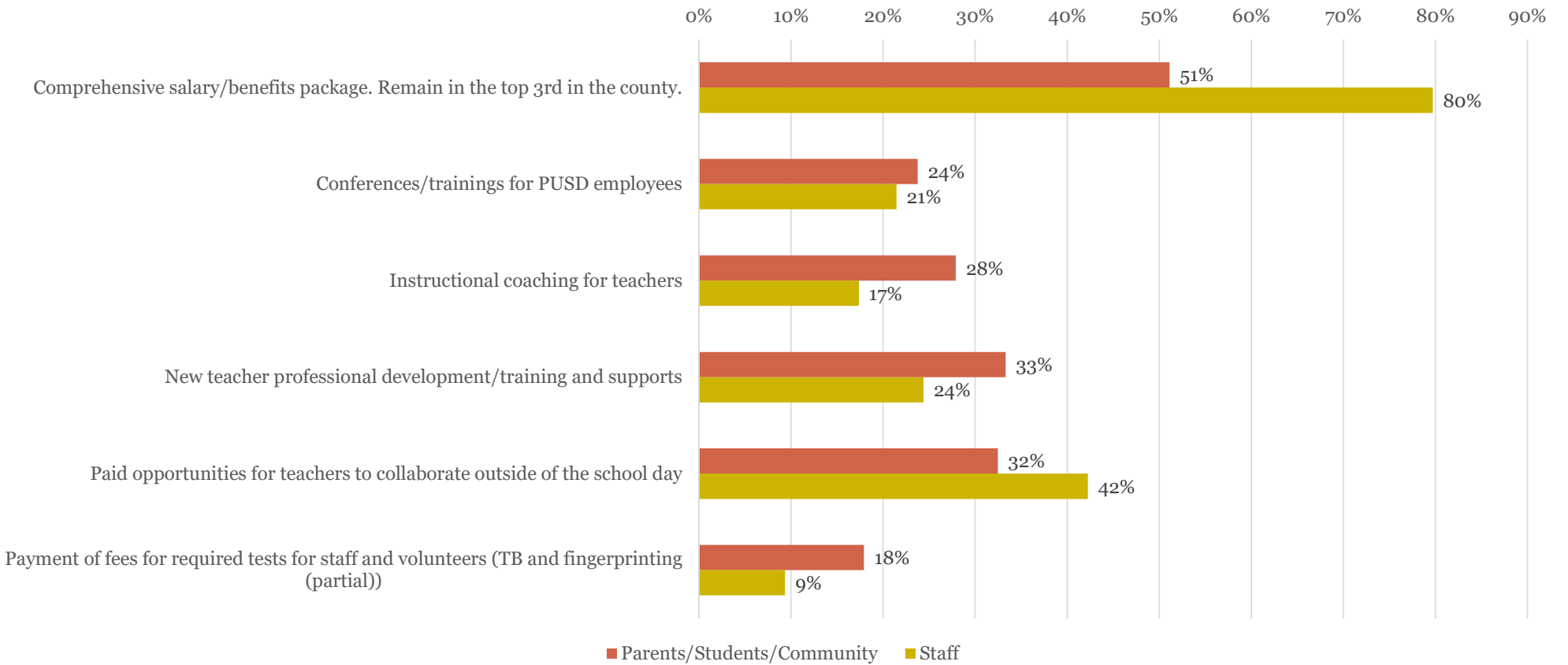
Student & Family Assets
