

Journal the Night Sky

Every day the Earth shifts a little so the sky will not look the same as it did the night before.

➤ Materials:

- Blank paper (lined/grid is fine)
- Pencil
- Paint brushes
- Paper plates



➤ Directions:

- Prepare your paper and pencil.
- Wait for it to get dark outside.
- Go outside or look out a window and draw what you see in the sky (moon, stars, clouds, plane, etc.)
- You can do this for a few days recording what you see each night in your drawings.
- On the last day, identify the differences you spotted in the night sky drawings.
