

# Neighborhood Car Hunt

## ➤ Materials:

- Paper (white or lined)
- Pen or pencil
- Colored pencils, crayons or markers

- Make a list of common car companies
- Go out for a 20 minute walk around your neighborhood with an adult or older sibling
- Observe the vehicles at every home or on the street that you pass by
- Make a tally next to the car's company for every car you see
- Create a line or column chart for the top 5 or 10 models you saw on your walk
- Get creative and have some fun drawing your favorite car/cars or the most unique car you saw while on your walk!
