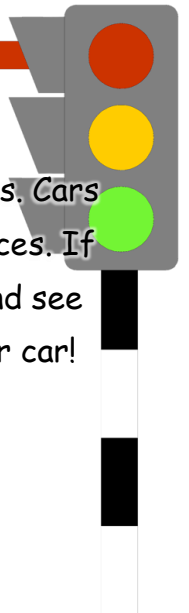


# Egg Carton Cars



In this activity, you will build your own egg carton cars and learn the importance of cars. Cars are an important part of transportation because they get us to and from different places. If we didn't have cars we would have to walk everywhere! You will reuse an egg carton and see how it can go from holding eggs to this fun activity. Get creative with the look of your car!

## ➤ Materials:

- Egg carton
- Paint
- Construction paper
- Marker
- Buttons
- Scissors



## ➤ Directions:

- Look around the house for the supplies. No matching buttons? That's okay! Just find buttons of similar size. Can't find buttons? Use a piece of cardboard to make the wheels.
- Have an adult help you with cutting out the individual pieces of the egg carton (the grooves that hold the eggs).
- Pick a color to use to paint your car. Once the car is dry cut out different pieces of construction paper for the headlights and windows on the car.
- Use a marker to draw on doors.
- Take the buttons (or cardboard) and glue on two on each side of the egg carton piece and leave them to dry for a while.
- Your car is all done! If your car could do one cool thing, what would it be?
