



ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCY ON THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Application Timeline: February 25th-March 11th

The Pittsburg Unified School District Board of Education is now accepting applications to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term of former Trustee Joe Arenivar. The term of this open seat will run from the date of the appointment until December, 2022. This seat will be open for election in November, 2022.

In accordance with Education Code Section 35107 to be eligible for election or appointment to a seat on the governing board of a school district a person must be:

- Eighteen (18) years of age or older
- A citizen of the state
- A resident within the boundaries of the Pittsburg Unified School District
- A registered California voter
- Not disqualified by the Constitution or laws of the state from holding a civil office
