The Governing Board of the Pittsburg Unified School District hereby certifies that as of this date, in accordance with the guidelines for expenditure of IMF (Instructional Material Funds) and/or funding for instructional materials from any state sources in a fiscal year in which the Superintendent of Public Instruction determines that the base revenue limit per average daily attendance (ADA) for each school district will increase by at least 1 percent from the prior fiscal year and as required by the William's Settlement (SB550), the board certifies that each pupil in kindergarten through grade twelve has been provided textbooks or instructional materials consistent with the state board adopted curriculum framework cycle.
