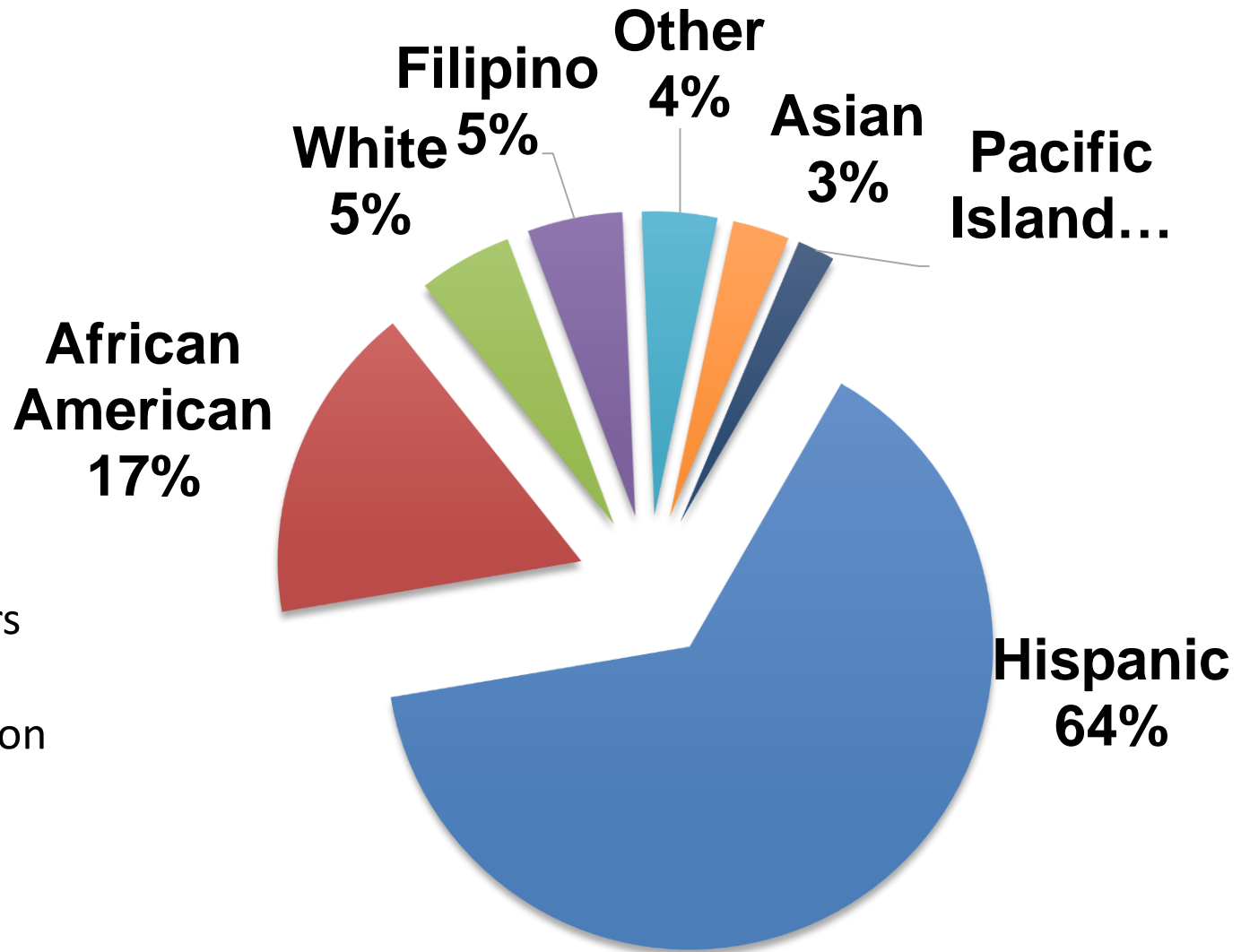

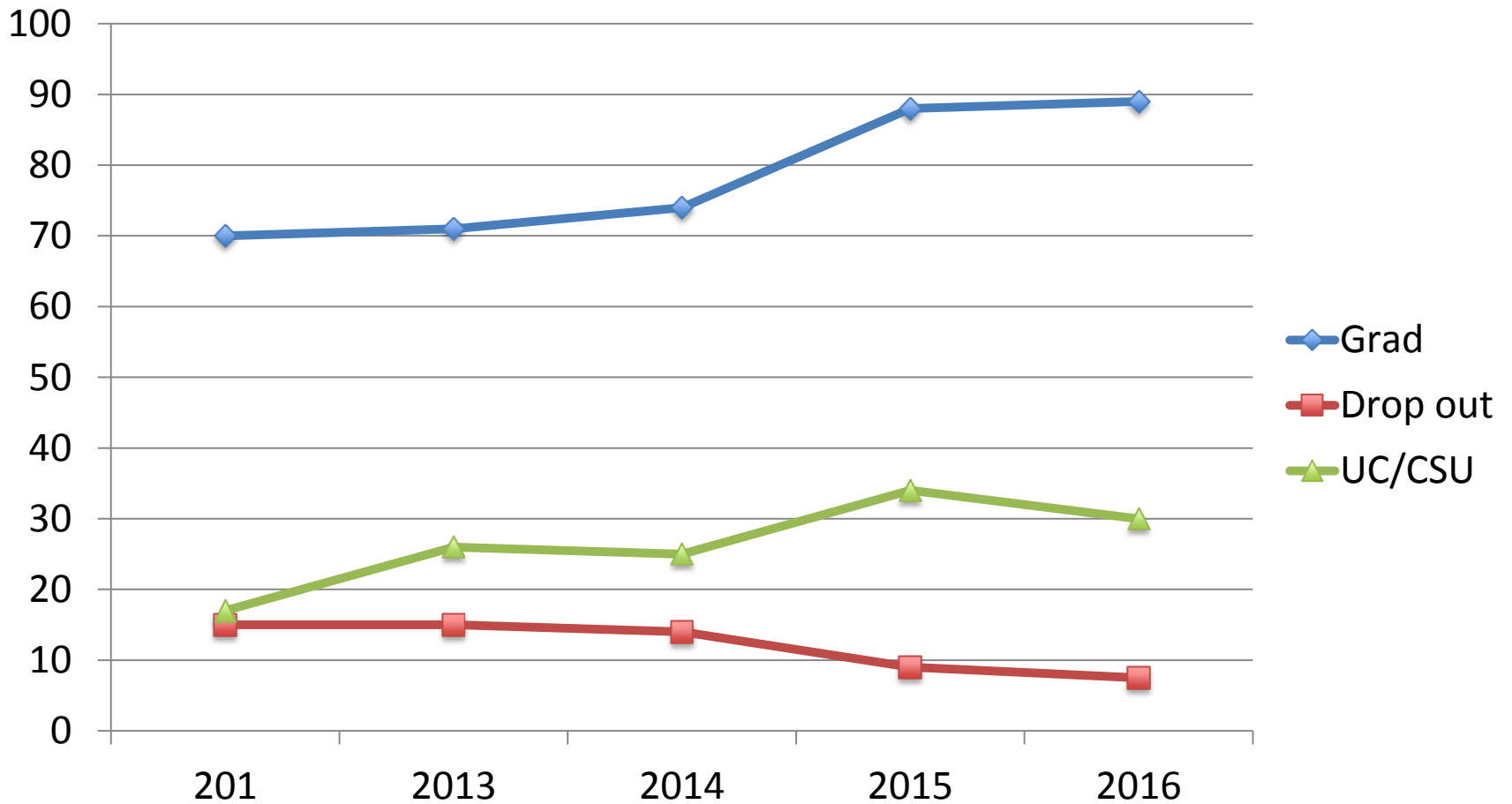

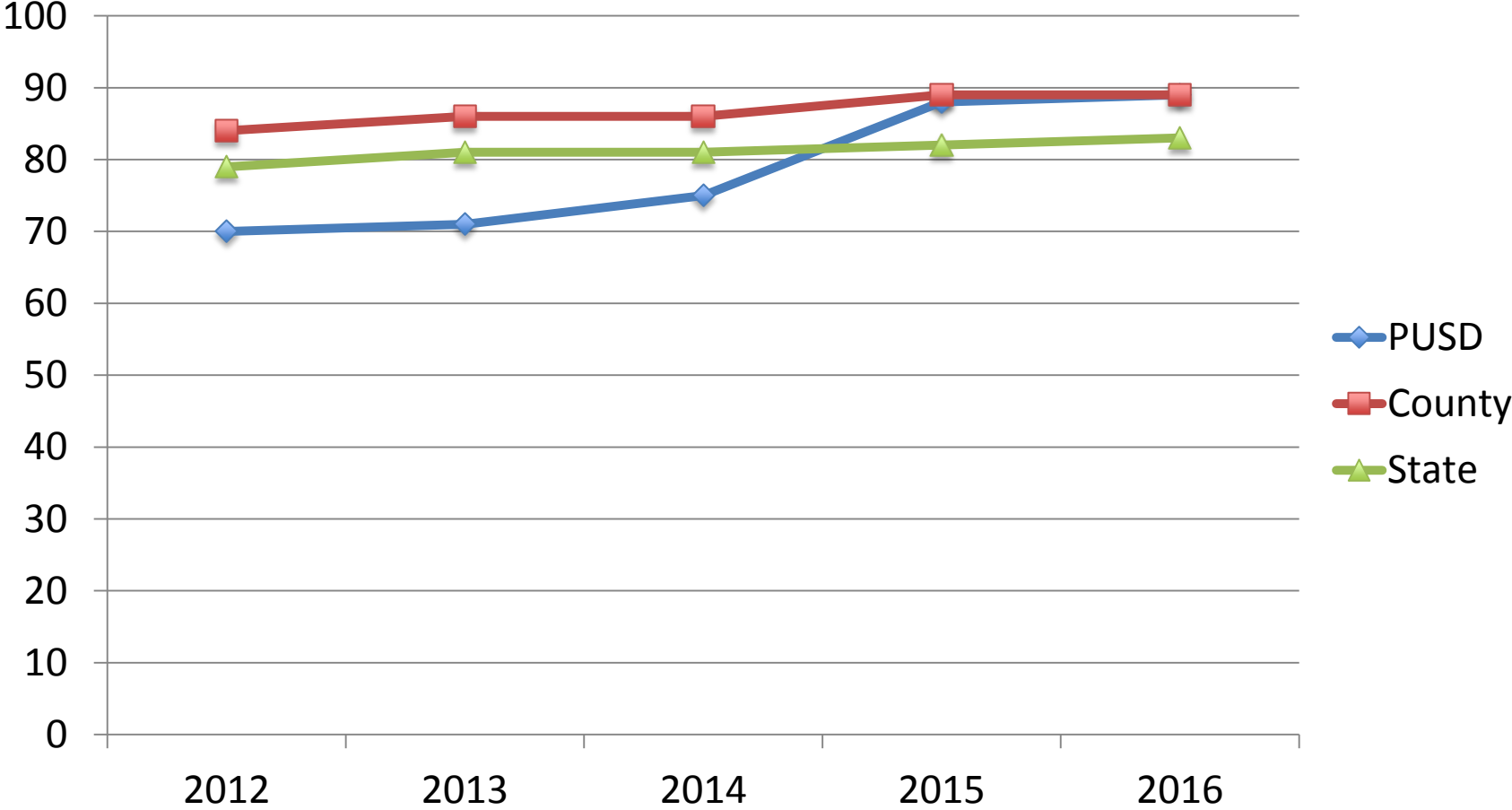

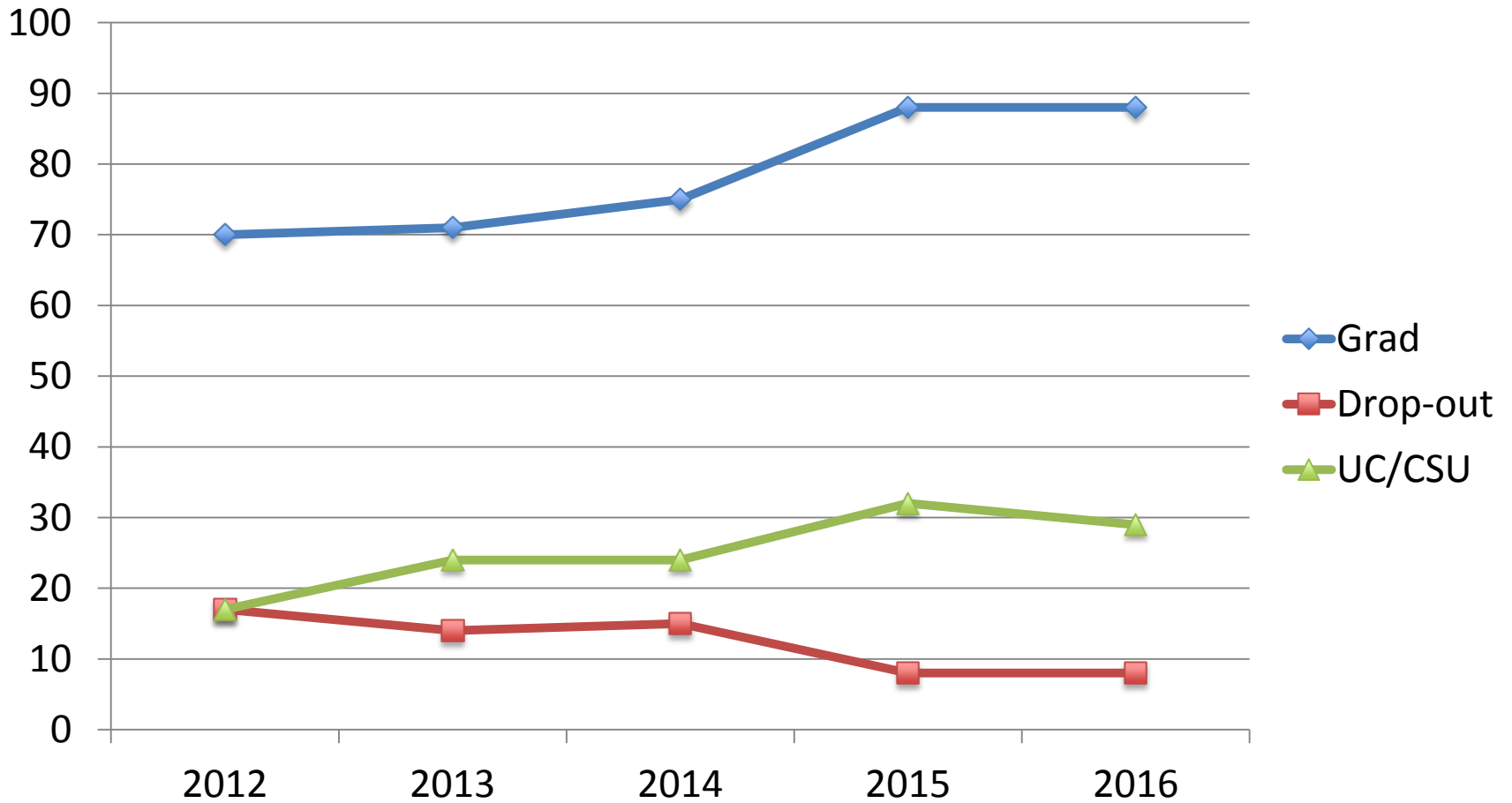
Five-Year Trends: PUSD



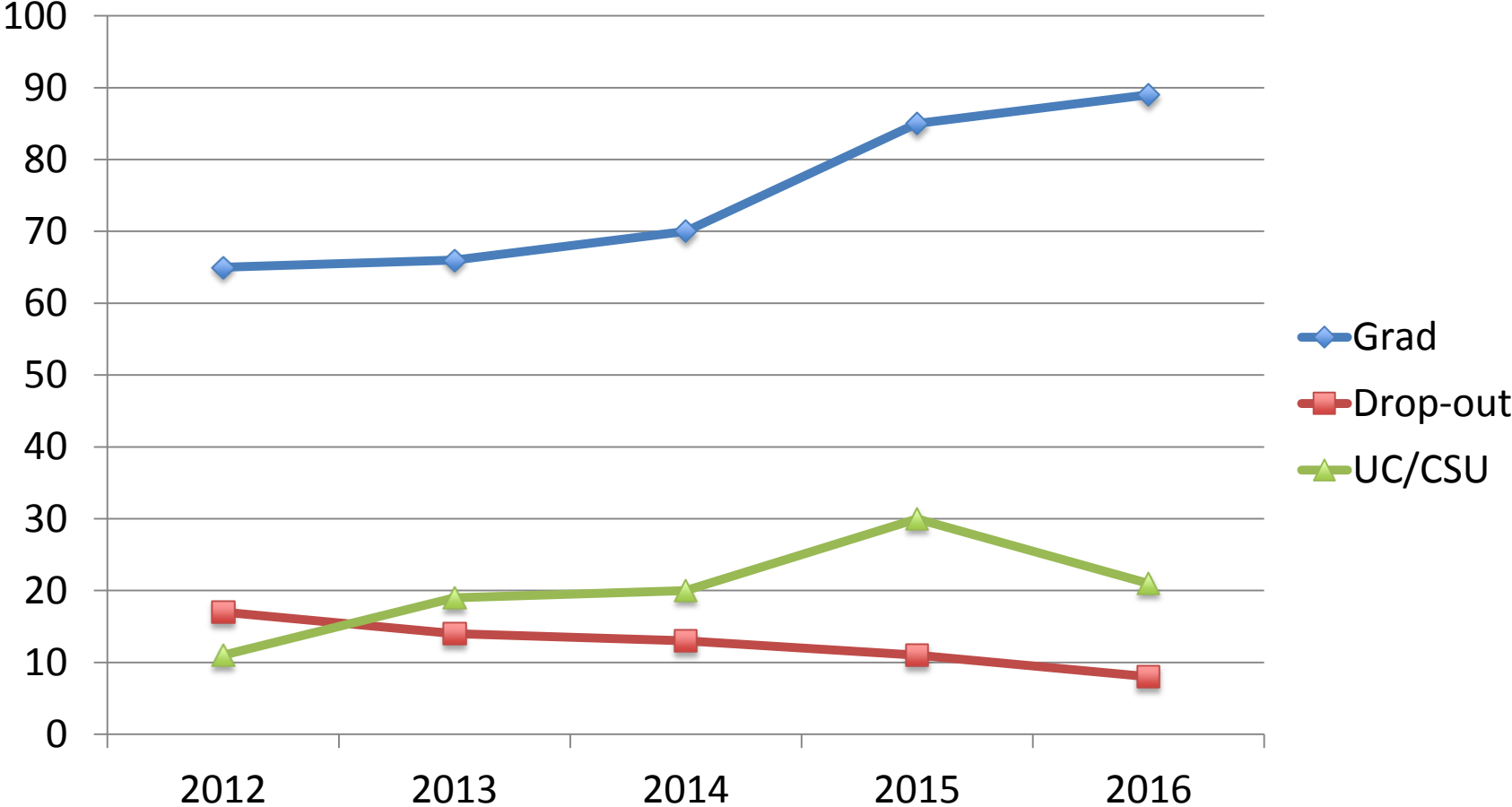
5-Year Trend Grad Rates Comparison



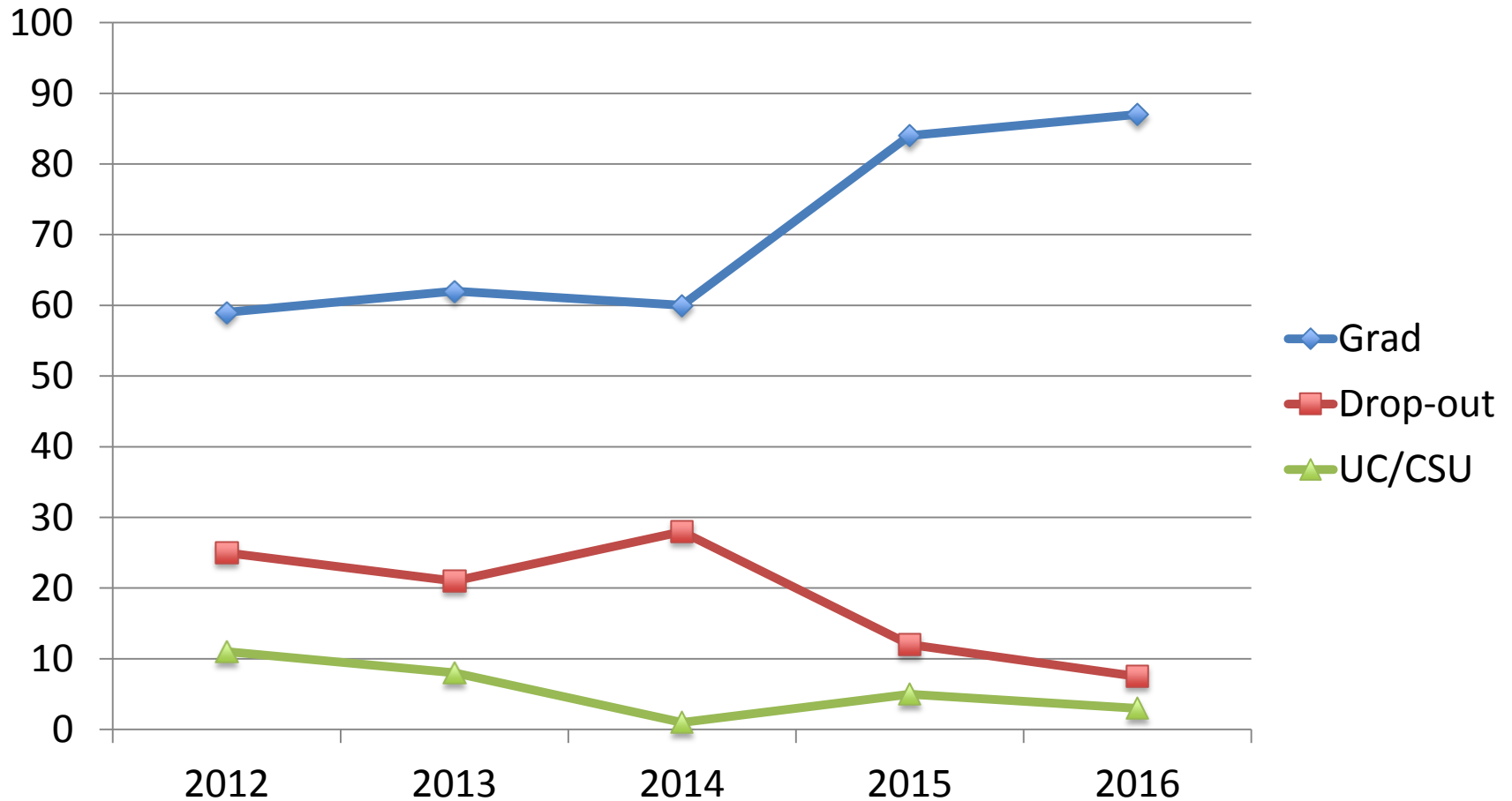
PUSD Five-Year Trends: Hispanic/Latino



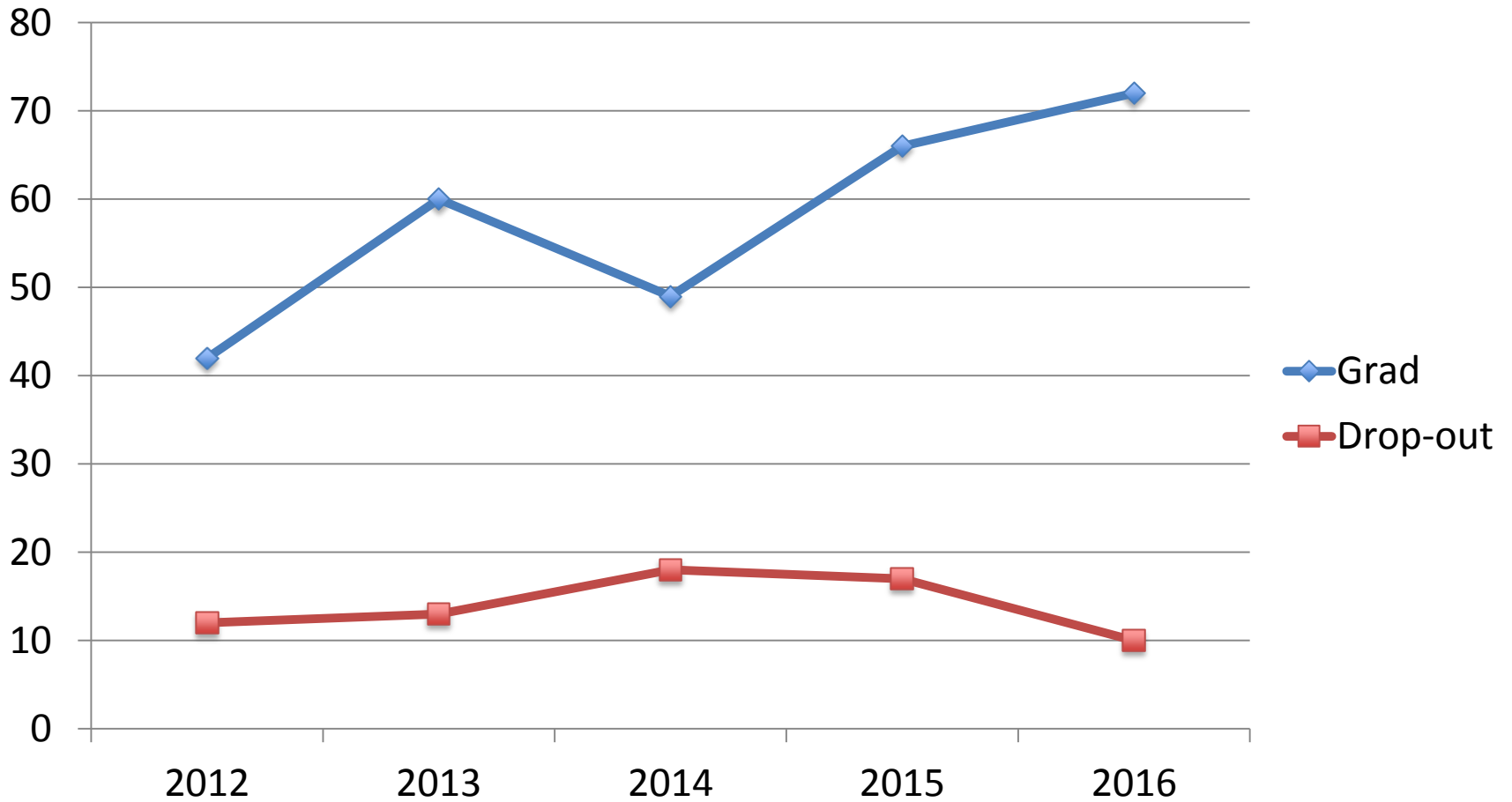
PUSD 5-Year Trends: African American

Main Points

- We have made significant gains in our graduation rates and decreases in our drop-out rates over the last 4 years
- We have accelerated the gains for our majority student groups so we no longer have a significant gap
- We are above the State and with the County for our Graduation Rates and we are significantly higher than both for all of our major student groups
- We have made growth but are significantly below the State and County for UC/CSU eligibility
